Old Business

- Budget approved.
- Brush pick up was discussed. Luke will look into options

- Meg Meinke gave an update from the Planning Board.
- A Vacancy must be filled on the Planning Board and Mildred Callear was suggested.
- Terms must be set for the Board commissioners.
