Unfinished Business

- The Maryland Historical Trust Grant (\$30,000), and The Maryland State Grant (\$85,000) have been approved. The money will be issued to the town following the Recording of the Easement by Attorney William Roberts.

New Business

- The Budget for FY 2011-2012 was passed.
- A letter was sent to Mr. Ruhl, and the issue will be resolved.
- The property across from the Menke property, on Old One Hundred Road, has been reported to the County. The County has assigned a work Number to this and is working to handle the situation.
- The Marc Train station will be cut back the brush around the curb and sign to help with excessive speed and blocked vision. Luke will set a meeting to discuss the matter further for more improvement. (Possible walkway and bike path)
- There have been property issues with the Ruhl's. Mr. Ruhl has not been responsive to the County. The County may go to the front door and site infractions.
- There unauthorized Dumping by Asplundh, on the Messigner Property, has been estimated as 45-50 loads per week. No money has changed hands, but the mulch piling higher is smoking. Scott Messigner may be living in a tent on the property as well. Luke has called the County regarding this issue, as well as the Asplundh.
- The new Town signs will be \$475 and the old need to be replaced. Most Townspeople preferred the Green with White emblems.
- The Post Office will not have window service on Saturdays although the Post Mistress will be onsite.
