- Commissioner Brown made the suggestion to have town hall as an emergency center – with generator, water and shelter for those needing it. Mayor Fedders will start getting prices for adding a generator and a shower to the existing bathroom at the town hall.
- Mayor Fedders is keeping in contact with Allegheny Power as to when the telephone pole and street light on the town hall property will be repaired from the storm damage.
